

SPAY/ NEUTER TAKE HOME INSTRUCTIONS

- STITCHES COME OUT IN TEN (10) DAYS FOLLOWING SURGERY DATE
 - PLEASE BRING PET BACK TO THE CLINIC TO HAVE STITCHES REMOVED TO INSURE THAT THE INCISION SITE IS HEALING PROPERLY
 - IF GLUE IS USED TO CLOSE THE INCISION NO RETURN VISIT IS NEEDED UNLESS THERE ARE ANY CONCERNS
- LIMITED ACTIVITY
 - NO RUNNING, JUMPING, CLIMBING, ETC.
- DISCOURAGE ANY LICKING, CHEWING, OR BITING AT THE INCISION SITE
 - AN E-COLLAR IS NEEDED IF PET BEGINS TO LICK, CHEW, OR BITE TO PREVENT ADDITIONAL SURGERY
- IF YOU NOTICE ANY SWELLING, REDNESS, OR OOZING FROM THE INCISION SITE, CALL THE ANIMAL HOSPITAL AT THE NUMBER LISTED BELOW OR STOP BY DURING OFFICE HOURS
- THE PET IS NOT TO HAVE A BATH OR PLAY IN ANY CREEKS, PONDS, POOLS, ETC. UNTIL 10 DAYS AFTER SURGERY OR STITCHES ARE REMOVED.
