FREE VACCINES FOR LIFE Program

We believe that it is very important for all pets to have regular physical exams and fecals....so here's an incentive to get pets in for their annual check-ups!!

Here's how the program works:

- After a one-time initiation fee, your pet will receive every "core" vaccine that it will ever need...for free. All you have to do is bring him in at least once per year for his physical exam/consult and fecal.
- While you will still be responsible for the cost of the annual exam and any testing or treatments that you and Dr. Pals or Dr. Clark feel your pet need, the savings you will see over the lifetime of your pet are phenomenal.

Frequently Asked Questions

Will my pet receive EVERY vaccine, EVERY time he or she visits Giles County Animal Hospital?

- No. Your pet will receive all of the vaccines that are currently recommended by the American Veterinary Medical Association and Dr. Pals and/or Dr. Clark as a "core" vaccine. Research is ALWAYS being done regarding vaccines and immunology...as the recommendations change and your pet's lifestyle and lifestage change, vaccine protocols will adjust. For most dogs, this means that Rabies, DA2PP and Bordetella are considered "core". For many dogs, Leptospirosis is also considered a "core" vaccine. Cats generally receive Rabies and FVRCP vaccines, and often Leukemia. Vaccines such as Lyme, influenza, giardia, FIV and several others are not considered "core", and as such are not included in this program.

If you decide not to continue to offer this program, what happens?

- If we decide not to offer the Free Vaccines For Life to new enrollees in the future, it will not affect our promise to you. We will stand by our promise for the life of EVERY enrolled pet.

If I enroll my pet in this program, can I use it at any other veterinarian's?

- No. The Free Vaccines For Life program is only available at Giles County Animal Hospital.

If I have more than one pet, does the discount apply to any of my other pets, or to those of my friends or family?

- No. Each pet must be enrolled separately. No other discounts apply with this program.

Can I transfer the program to another pet?

- No. The program is non-transferrable between pets. However, you may enroll as many pets as you like.

If I give away or sell my pet to a new family, can the new owner use the program?

- Yes. The program may be transferred to a new owner.

If my pet dies or runs away shortly after enrolling in the program, may I get a refund?

- No. The enrollment fee is non-refundable.

How much does this cost?

- For only \$179.95 for adult dogs and cats or \$199.95 for puppies or kittens, your pet can receive all of its core vaccines for the rest of its life. The savings can start **THE SAME DAY YOU JOIN!**
